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## Minutes of a Parish Council Meeting held in Tissington Village Hall

on Monday 21 March 2022 at 7 pm

### Present:

### 1. Welcome and apologies for absence

CLLr FitzHerbert welcomed everyone to the meeting. Apologies were received from CLLr John Etches.

### 2. Declarations of Interest

CLLr FitzHerbert declared an interest as a District Councillor.

### 3. Approval of Minutes of meetings held on the 31 January 2022 and the extraordinary meeting held on the 28 February 2022

The Council resolved to accept the minutes of the last 2 meetings as a true record of those meetings proposed by CLLr FitzHerbert seconded by CLLr Naylor.

### 4. Matters Arising from the last meeting

The Peak Park Planning Authority had refused a recent planning application for a new dwelling in the village. CLLr Carr expressed his disappointment that the Parish Council had not been able to support the application and stated that the village needed young families in order for it to be sustainable.

### 5. General Business:

#### a) Village Events for 2022 – Well Dressings/Garden Party

The Well Dressings would start on Thursday 26 May and plans are well in hand. FitzHerbert School were to be invited to design the Children's Well. A village litter pick was planned for Saturday 26 March. The Garden Party was planned for Sunday 31 July. Date/s for the village Open Gardens were still to be finalised. The Village Hall Committee had received £150 for the Queens Jubilee.

#### b) Main Entrance to the Village - Visibility Issues

A resident had raised concerns regarding visibility when exiting the village through the main gates. After discussion the Council agreed that they would monitor the situation.

### 6. Financial Report & Administration:

#### a) Clerk's National Pay Award

The Clerk explained that clerks had been awarded a pay award of 1.75% backdated to 1 April 2021. The Council approved the award and payment of the backdated salary.

#### b) Financial Statement

The financial statement showed a balance in the account of £4,367.39.

#### c) Items for approval and payment at this meeting

The Council approved the payment of the following items, proposed by CLLr FitzHerbert, seconded by CLLr Carr; the Council resolved that these payments be made electronically:

**8. Village Highways/Tissington Estate Business:**

**a) Update on items previously reported**

- Potholes on Flatts Lane – these had still not been repaired. Photos supplied and to be submitted to County Highways. Cllr Edwards-Walker had seen the lane being swept but it did not stay clear for long.
- Broken Fence & Cattle Grid on Bent Lane – this had now been repaired by Tissington Estate.
- Pedestrian Gate at the Cattle Grid near the Candle Factory – this had now been repaired and Councillors agreed to make sure that this was working effectively.
- Sweeping of Flatts Lane – This work had still not been done. Clerk to follow up.
- White Lines at Narlow Lane junction and the Old Dog – these had now been painted.
- Mud and subsidence in The Foot – This work was still outstanding.

There were no further highway issues raised at this meeting.
